

UNIFORM AND DRESS CODE

PURPOSE

Woodside Primary School Council has determined that the wearing of school uniforms would be compulsory for the following reasons:

A school uniform

- develops a sense of unity
- fosters a sense of belonging to the school;
- establishes the identity of the school;
- creates a positive image of the school;
- provides practical clothing for school activities;
- eliminates peer pressure caused by competition with dress.

CODE AND GROOMING EXPECTATIONS

- Students will wear the recommended uniform at all times.
- Hats, as supplied by the school, are to be worn in accordance with the school's SUNSMART Policy.
- Students representing the school on day excursions; participating in inter-school sports or other special activities must wear the recommended uniform. If not in uniform they will be provided with a uniform for that day.

HEALTH AND SAFETY ASPECTS OF THE SCHOOL UNIFORM

- Footwear needs to completely enclose the foot, and be suitable for every day school activities, no skate shoes or similar.
- Loose jewellery is not permitted.

LOST ITEMS

- The school makes provision for the return of lost property and uniform items that are clearly labelled.
- The school will not accept responsibility for lost and damaged personal items belonging to students.

PROVISION OF UNIFORM

- Uniforms can be purchased through the school.
- The school has an extensive range of second hand uniform. It is free and available to all students. Please contact the office and arrange to peruse the range.
